You will need to pack a **SACK LUNCH & DRINK** for the 1st day. Please be sure your lunch has your name on it and is disposable. We will have ice chests to keep them cold.

What to bring

- Bible
- Water Bottle (Large opening to put in ice)
- Sunscreen
- Flashlight
- Soap/Toiletries
- Tennis shoes (closed toe shoes)
- Comfortable clothes (shorts should be mid thigh, tops are modest)
- Swimsuit (modest suit please) & Swim shoes is desired
- Girls bring a cover up and/or t-shirt for after swimming/ Boys wear t-shirts
- Large Beach towel for swimming & stargazing
- Towels and wash cloths for bathing
- Sleeping bag or sheets and pillow (campers will sleep on a twin bed)
- Large trash bags for dirty clothes
